

Pivot is the **NEWEST** and **BEST** Kentucky Bluegrass variety for athletic field sodding and seeding! Pivot, in a word, is **DURABLE!** Its superior seedling vigor, sod tensile strength, and fast "tear recoverability" gave the variety its name. Pivot is also highly resistant to many diseases, like Leaf Spot, Rust, Melting Out, Powdery Mildew, Stripe Smut, Fusarium Blight, Dollar Spot, Pythium Blight and Red Thread.
