Turf trials were established August 2007 at Verboort, Oregon and September 2007 at Lewisburg, Pennsylvania. Experimental design was randomized complete block with three replications for both locations. Cutting height at both locations was 1.5 inches. Both trials received 6 pounds of actual Nitrogen from the fall of 2007 through the summer of 2008. Irrigation was applied to prevent stress. Total entries at each trial location were 30. The turf performance data is from 2008.

Ratings were made using a 1-9 scale for each trait as follows:

Turfgrass quality where 9 = ideal turf, Color where 9 = darkest green, Density where 9 = most dense and Leaf texture where 9 = very fine.
