HARD FESCUE

Harpoon is a very fine leaved grass with a rich, darker green color that does well in low maintenance sites such as roadsides and highway medians. Harpoon is very tolerant of poor soils and prefers low fertility and thrives in low nitrogen soils, sunny areas and excessive shade. It tolerates both cold and heat very well. Harpoon makes an excellent erosion control ground cover and performs well at both low and high mowing heights. Harpoon is very deep rooted, with a high root to shoot ratio.
