




Jonathan Green Flying Eagle grass seeds are advanced shade tolerant varieties of fine fescues. Basically bunch-type grasses that have been developed in our breeding program to have insect and disease resistance, while blending very well with other elite grass varieties, "Soaring above the ordinary."



Flying Eagle Fine Fescues have great drought tolerance. This photo was taken in August after 45 days without irrigation.

## FINE FESCUES

Chewing Fescue: Festuca rubra commutata

*Creeping Red Fescue: Festuca rubra* 

Hard Fescue: Festuca longifolia

- Highly advanced shade tolerance, best adapted to shady locations that are damp
- Will do well in sunny areas, with adequate moisture
- Mixes very well with other grasses
- Low maintenance requirements for fertilization, water and mowing
- Performs well in poor, infertile soils of lower pH
- Endophyte enhanced to reduce insect damage
- Approximately 10 to 14 days to germinate
